

# Science to play a key role in industry 4.0, says PM Narendra Modi



**AHMEDABAD:** Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Saturday said that science is pivotal in India's development in 21st century and it would play an important role in the fourth industrial revolution. He was speaking virtually at the inaugural session of the two-day Centre-State Science Conclave organized at Gujarat Science City in Ahmedabad.

The PM stressed on celebrating the achievements of Indian scientists adding that several Indian scientists such as C V Raman, J C Bose, S Bose, Meghnad Saha and S Chandrasekhar came up with innovations in the last century.

PM Narendra Modi on Saturday asked science and technology ministers from all Indian states to take full advantage of the abilities and expertise of the national-level scientific institutes and national laboratories in their states. He was speaking virtually at the inaugural ceremony of the two-day Centre-State Science Conclave organized at Science City in Ahmedabad. "We also have to take our science-related institutions out of the state of silos for optimum utilization of scientific institutions and expertise," said the PM, asking state ministers to share good practices and aspects of their science curriculum. The conclave will include sessions

along with scientists, industry representatives and educationists among others. "Science is like that energy in the development of 21st century India, which has the power to accelerate the development of every region and the development of every state. Today, when India is moving towards leading the fourth industrial revolution, the role of India's science and people related to this field is very important," said the PM during his address, adding that anusandhan (research and evolution) is also now part of New India with Jai Jawan, Jai Kisan and Jai Vigyan. He asked the citizens to make the celebration of scientists and scientific achievement part of society and culture.

# Model bylaws ready to make agricultural credit societies multipurpose: Union minister Amit Shah



**AMRELI:** The Centre plans to make primary agricultural credit societies (PACS) "multipurpose" with facilities for marketing, godowns, making gobar (dung) gas, electricity bill collection, gas distribution agencies and Nal Se Jal scheme, and that model bylaws for the same are ready, Union Home and Cooperation Minister Amit Shah said on Sunday.

The government also plans to form a multi-state cooperative society for seed collection and marketing as well as certification of organic products across the country, Shah said at the annual general meeting of seven cooperative institutions of Amreli district in Gujarat, where assembly elections are due later this year.

"Seva Sahkari Mandali (PACS) will be made multipurpose with facilities for marketing, godowns, making gobar (dung) gas, electricity bill collection, facility for gas distribution agencies, Nal Se Jal scheme, etc. Model bylaws are ready for this multipurpose mandali, and it will be sent to you before September-end," he said.

"The country's PACS will be multi-purpose and profit-making," the minister added. Shah further said the government also aims to raise

bank accounts of farmers," he said.

Shah also informed meeting about setting up a multi-state cooperative export house to export agricultural products to the world market for the benefit of the farmers.

Attacking opposition parties, Shah said when Congress was in power in Gujarat, all dairy cooperatives in the state's Saurashtra region were closed down giving an opportunity to private players to exploit milk producers.

After Modi was the chief

minister of Gujarat, cooperative dairies started functioning properly, he said.

Shah also said the idea of setting up a separate cooperation ministry was given by the then Minister of State for Agriculture Parshottam Rupala.

Rupala, who was present at the event, is now the Union Minister of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying. "When Rupala was the Minister of State for Agriculture, he talked about the condition of cooperative leaders in Krishi Bhavan. If

there is anybody who first told Narendra Modi (Modi) about setting up a separate cooperation ministry, it is Parshottam Rupala," Shah said.

"Later Modi asked me to inquire and see what can be done. I said there was nothing to inquire about as it is something that needs to be done, so let us do this. Prime Minister Modi then formed a separate cooperation ministry as a new effort to make crores of farmers of the country prosperous," he said.

# Gujarat: Rs 4,000 crore donations unearthed at RUPPs



**AHMEDABAD:** The ongoing search by the income tax (I-T) department on the registered unrecognized political parties (RUPPs) in the state has fetched records of the donations to the tune of Rs 4,000 crore in the past three financial years. The sleuths said that the search on 23 parties - primarily based in Ahmedabad - also threw light on the modus operandi employed by the persons involved.

Sources close to the department said that the search - carried out since Wednesday at 130 places in five states involving 600 I-T officers - was carried out after

months of meticulous planning. "After the earlier search in February 2021, it came to light that some political parties which have negligible or no ground presence used to get funds from the individuals who wanted to claim rebate under sections 80 GGB and GGC. Moreover, the parties are also suspected to be laundering money," said sources, adding that many parties involved were found to be established in past one year.

Giving an example, the officials said that the persons involved would get the donation through cheques and get 3-5% of the cut. "The

persons would prepare another cheque of a similar amount and show it as expense, settling the balance. It would happen sometimes in as many as two to seven layers as the 'donor' would get the money back in cash," said sources. "If someone had unaccounted cash and needed cheque to make the money legit, they would also get these cheques."

While some of the party officers were found to be running watch shop or auto drivers, the addresses were often obscure or non-existent. The sources said that the I-T department would approach banks to make the KYC procedures more stringent. "About 40-odd chartered accountants, who are found to be involved with the case, would also be scrutinized for their roles. It's likely that the racket was well-thought out as many of the 'donors' were found to be doctors, lawyers, businessmen, etc. Scrutiny of the seized documents would further reveal the persons involved," said sources.



## Ambient air cleaning project to be tested in Pandesara GIIC



of an entire industrial area. Hence, a boundary will be identified based on the wind direction and local conditions. The air within that boundary will be tested to measure the efficacy of the purification system," said Robin Christian, professor, SVNIT. "The location has not been finalized yet but one near a school in Pandesara has been proposed for the trials. There will be air filters inside the plant that purifies the air," said Christian. The project is being undertaken with support from Pandesara Infrastructure Ltd, a special purpose vehicle (SPV) run by the local industries that operates the water treatment plant and deals with pollution-related issues. "Various technologies to clean ambient air are being tested and tried. We have also agreed to fund the project if the technology works," said Jitendra Vakharia, president. PNL, SVNIT researchers will not only monitor the air pollution through automatic devices but also carry out manual testing at regular intervals. "There will be sensors installed but our

study will not be based on this data alone. We will do testing manually as well," added Christian. The study to span six weeks includes installation and removal of plants. "A similar small plant has been installed in Mumbai and a study on a larger scale is being developed in New Delhi," he added.
